

Tri-County Technical College Athletics Department Policy on Substance Abuse

In accordance with regulations outlined by the NJCAA, the use of illegal drugs or substances used as performance aids will not be tolerated in athletics at Tri-County Technical College (TCTC).

In addition, TCTC student-athletes are subject to the College's policies regarding alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs as outlined in the College Catalog.

Any student using illegal drugs or alcohol connected with the transportation of athletic teams to or from an athletic event will be immediately released from the athletic team and will face disciplinary action from the College.

Athletes found to be violators of the aforementioned regulations or those who in the judgment of the athletics department staff have a substance abuse problem will be referred for counseling. Athletics department staff will address substance abuse problems in a professional and confidential manner and will strive to assist student-athletes in addressing any problems associated with substance abuse.
